



2017 Conflict Resolution Day Bookmark Art Contest!

The Dispute Resolution Center of Montgomery County, Inc. (DRC-MC) seeks entries for its 2017 Conflict Resolution Day Bookmark Art Contest. The contest is open to all Montgomery County students in grades K through 8.

Categories: Level 1= Kindergarten through Second grade; Level 2= Third through Fifth grade; and Level 3 = Sixth through Eighth Grade.

Prizes: Bookmarks will be judged on creativity and message conveyed. The following prizes will be awarded for each category: 1st Place: Winner will receive \$75.00; 2nd Place: Winner will receive \$50.00; 3rd Place: Winner will receive \$25.00; and Honorable Mention Winner will receive \$10.00.

To Enter: Submit original artwork in book mark size (3 inches high by 9 inches wide) or on a 8½ x 11 inch sheet of paper, with the image size being no larger than 3 inches high by 9 inches wide. Please be sure that the student's name, age and grade, school or program name, teacher's name and an address are included with each bookmark entry. Please **DO NOT FOLD BOOKMARK.**

Theme: Bookmark art must reflect a conflict resolution or prevention theme, such as peer mediation, talking things out, apologizing, respecting differences, solving problems together, listening, tolerance, peace building, or alternatives to violence.

Deadline: **All original artwork must be received on or before 5:00 p.m. on September 29, 2017. Winners will be listed on the DRC-MC website by Tuesday, October 10, 2017. Faxed or emailed bookmarks will not be accepted.**

An awards ceremony will be held on Friday, October 20, 2017, at 4:00 p.m. Judge Kathleen Hamilton will present awards to the winners. Winning bookmarks will also be displayed at the Montgomery County Memorial Library System, Central Branch.
