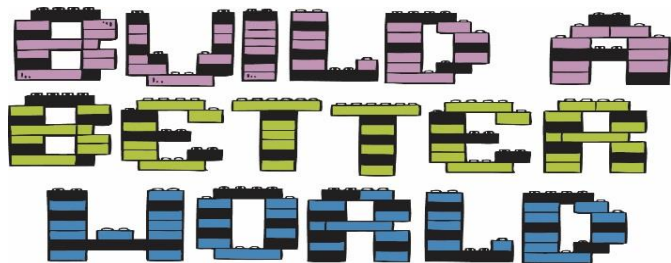

Texas Reading Club Rules

Each dot on the reading log represents one book or 30 minutes.

Once you complete a reading log with ten colored dots you may turn in the log to qualify for a reading certificate, book, coupons from local businesses, and your name displayed in the library.

Children may begin reading for the program beginning May 30th, even if they have not yet registered for the program.

The last day to report books is Friday, July 14th by 3:00 pm! If you are going to be out of town during that time please call or come by to report books before the final date.

You cannot turn in a log on the same day you receive it.
